EEP curriculum nearly completed!

After an intensive piloting of the draft EEP curriculum and facilitator guide in all partner countries, project partners have started to collect and process the feedback from participants and facilitators. This process will be finished by the end of March, after which the Erasmus Employment Plus curriculum and facilitator guide will be translated into each national partner language, creating a new and exciting resource for guidance practitioners supporting people with limited qualifications.

Due to Covid-19 restrictions, on February 17, the 6th project partner meeting of the EEP project was held online. Participants from all partner countries – UK, Poland, Spain, Bulgaria, Austria and the Netherlands – gathered to discuss the outcomes and feedback of the curriculum piloting conducted in each country. The pilot phase was to test the previously created exercises and tools by guidance practitioners who are experienced in guiding clients with limited skills and qualifications.

In the project, a curriculum consisting of four modules is developed:

- Module 1: Client's orientation and needs analysis
- Module 2: Vocational choices
- Module 3: Learning motivation and learning styles
- Module 4: Practitioner well-being and burnout-prevention

Next to the curriculum and corresponding facilitator guide, the project partners also develop an online assessment tool, making it possible for participants to move along the curriculum according to their needs, preferences and prior knowledge and experience. To present the project results to the national stakeholders – guidance practitioners, educational providers, social institutions and the public in general – in all partner countries a multiplier event will be organized in May or June. As part of these multiplier events, additional good practices for providing vocational guidance for people with limited skills and qualifications will be presented.

Afterwards, these good practices will be documented and published. Invitations to EEP's final conference will also be open to the public, taking place in July 2021.
